CHS After Prom Request

Councilman Claycamp moved to donate \$1000 to the CHS After Prom Celebration for the 2022 Prom night. Motion was seconded by Councilman Smith. After discussion, motion passed 3-2. Councilman Schoneboom and Councilman Ghormley voted against.

Public Works Truck Purchase

Councilman Schoneboom moved to approve the replacement of the 2003 pickup in the public works department in the amount of \$36,955. Councilman Ghormley seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

City Street Maintenance

Councilman Smith moved to authorize City Administrator, Public Works Supervisor and Councilman Smith to determine the necessary work scope for city street maintenance in accordance with the established three-year plan. Final expenditures for street maintenance in 2022 not to exceed \$150,000. Motion was seconded by Councilman Schoneboom. Motion passed 5-0.
